The present application has been filed by the RP seeking extension of CIRP by 90 days. The period of 180 days has expired on 26.08.2019. The CoC in its third meeting at agenda item no. 12 had deliberated on the issue of extension of CIRP period. The details of the voting results along with the minutes of the said meeting is annexed, which reflects that out of total votes casted by the CoC members with 96.19% voting share have voted in favour of the said resolution which comply with the mandate as required under the Code.
